**Summary:** Please implement updates made to the Construction Electrician and Industrial Electrician program outlines.

**Details:** In response to industry feedback collected at a post-harmonization webinar on training sequencing held November 30, 2021, and in consultation with the BC Electrician Articulation Committee, the competency *Install Motor Starters and Controls* will be taught in Level 1. The competency continues to be taught in Levels 2 and 3.

Also, references to the Canadian Electrical Code (CEC) have been added as needed throughout the Program Outlines.

The revised Program Outlines have been posted to the ITA [Construction Electrician](#) and [Industrial Electrician](#) trade pages.

Training Providers can implement the changes immediately, or by June 1, 2023.
