Summary: Apprentices with Current Level 2 (CL2) or Current Level 3 (CL3)

As of September 1, 2021, the AST program is fully harmonized. All harmonized levels of technical training have been implemented and all levels of the current program have been

phased out.

If **apprentices from the current program** are interested in registering for Harmonized Level 3 (HL3) or Harmonized Level 4 (HL4), please have them contact their <u>Apprenticeship Advisor</u> to discuss potential gaps in their training <u>before they are registered in harmonized HL3 or HL4 technical training</u>. Northern Lights College will be offering centralized, online gap training for

apprentices who have completed CL2 or CL3.

The <u>Transition Plan</u> on the trade page has been updated.

Background: On February 27, 2017, ITA Program Standards issued OPSN 2017-002, which detailed the

changes to the Automotive Service Technician Program as a result of the Harmonization Initiative and announced the implementation of a revised Program Outline, effective September

1, 2017.
