## Issued: June 27, 2016 Program: Construction Craft Worker (Labourer) **ITA Training Providers** To: **Articulation Chair** System Liaison Person School Districts **Construction Craft Worker (Labourer) Level 1** Subject: Launch of ITA Standardized Level Exam RE: **OPSN 2016-010** Effective Date: August 1, 2016 Summary: ITA is introducing standardized exams for Level 1 of the Construction Craft Worker (CCW) program. Classes of apprentice technical training for Level 1 of the CCW program that begin after August 1, 2016 will be required to sit an ITA Level Exam. The exam will contribute 20% to an apprentice's final mark. CCW Level 1 SLE is also available for challenge. Rationale: ITA is implementing Standardized Level Exams as part of an assessment strategy to ensure consistent outcomes at each program level for apprentices throughout BC. Scheduling Exams: Exams are to be requested by training providers via the usual ITA procedure. Training providers are required to complete an ITA Exam Request Form six-to-eight weeks prior to the scheduled exam date. ITA will invigilate these exams unless other arrangements are organized between ITA's Exam Department and the training provider. **Calculating Final Process – effective October 1, 2014** (refer to Figure 1) **Percentage Scores** For ITA Level ITA administers the SLE, records the mark in Direct Access, and reports it to Exams the school. The apprentice is **not** notified when the SLE mark is entered. • Training providers weight and blend the in-school (80%) and SLE (20%) marks to produce a final mark for the Level (or as indicated in the Assessment Guidelines). That final, blended mark is reported to ITA by the school and recorded in Direct Access.


• Direct Access reports the school's final blended mark for the Level to the

apprentice as a single percentage score.

• Once the final Level mark is entered in Direct Access, the system performs a reverse calculation using the SLE mark to determine the in-school mark. All three marks are stored in the apprentice's record, but only the final Level mark is reported on the ITA transcript.

A percentage score of 70% or greater is required to pass when the final in-school percentage score and the final ITA Level exam percentage score are blended.

Interprovincial Red Seal Exam	Certification exam results are <b><u>not</u></b> blended with in-school technical training results in the final Level of the program. Interprovincial Red Seal exams remain stand-alone
(Final Level – Level 2)	program completion requirements.
	In order to achieve certification, CCW apprentices are required to write the Interprovincial Red Seal exam after their final level (level 2) of technical training.
	To be eligible to write the certification exam, apprentices must have passed all Levels of in-school technical training. Certification exams are requested by training providers via the usual ITA procedure
	A score of 70% or greater is required for a pass on certification exams.
	ITA administers and invigilates the certification exams and records exam results in ITA Direct Access.
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
