Summary of Please be advised that a new Piledriver and Bridgeworker Program Profile and Program

**Change:** Outline has been posted to the Industry Training Authority (ITA) website.

Rationale: Changes to the Piledriver and Bridgeworker Program Profile and Program Outline were

made as a result of changes made to Carpenter Level 2 during the Carpenter

Harmonization process.

**Details:** Currently, Piledriver and Bridgeworker apprentices take Carpenter Level 2. When the

Carpenter trade went through the Harmonization process, content from Carpenter Level 2 was redistributed through the other levels. Carpenter Level 2 was subsequently no

longer an appropriate fit for the Piledriver and Bridgeworker program.

A Piledriver and Bridgeworker Program Review was conducted in June 2016 to develop

a Piledriver and Bridgeworker-specific Level 2. Changes to the Piledriver and Bridgeworker Program Profile were then made to accommodate those changes.
